ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 386)

[Passed March 24, 1934; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the city of Grafton, West Virginia, a municipal corporation, to set aside from the general revenues of said city, other than direct property taxes levied on real estate and personal property, a sum not to exceed five thousand dollars annually, to be used in the repayment of any sum of money borrowed by the city of Grafton from the reconstruction finance corporation, or other federal governmental agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing, equipping, maintaining and operating a municipally owned hospital, in or near the city of Grafton, the authority to annually set aside the said sum and use it for said purpose, to exist until the sum or sums so borrowed shall be repaid, and to enact proper ordinance to carry out the provisions of this act, and to pledge the sums so set aside for the repayment of said loan.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The city of Grafton, Taylor county, West Virginia, a municipal corporation, is authorized to set aside from the general revenues of said city, other than taxes levied directly on real estate and personal property, a sum not to exceed five thousand dollars annually, to be used for and in the repayment of any sum or sums of money borrowed by the city of Grafton from the reconstruction finance corporation or other federal governmental agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing, equipping, maintaining and operating a municipally owned hospital, in or near the city of Grafton, under the authority of chapter sixty-eight, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three. The authority to annually set aside and use for said purpose, the said sum from the general revenues of the city of Grafton, other than taxes levied directly on real estate and personal property, shall exist until the sum or sums so borrowed for said purpose is repaid. This authority shall be additional to the authority vested in said city of Grafton by virtue of said chapter sixty-eight, acts of the Legislature, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three,
