AN ACT to amend and reenact section ten, chapter sixteen, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, relating to redemption of delinquent lands.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section ten, chapter sixteen, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 10. The time within which real estate sold for the 2 nonpayment of taxes and purchased by the state may be re-3 deemed as provided in section thirty, article ten, chapter eleven 4 of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-5 one, for each of the years one thousand nine hundred twenty-6 nine, one thousand nine hundred thirty, one thousand nine
