AN ACT to amend and reenact section twenty, chapter sixty, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, entitled, 'An act to provide for the appointment and promotion of members of paid fire departments in cities and municipalities, to provide for the creation and maintenance of a civil service commission for the purpose, to establish rules and procedure therefor; to regulate the manner in which demotions and discharge of employees of paid fire departments shall be made, and the rights and limitations of said employees in that respect; to provide for other matters relating to the duties and power of said civil service commission, defining its power, limiting its authority, etc., and to provide penalties for the violation of this bill', by providing that the provisions of said act shall not apply to the

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twenty, chapter sixty, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 20. The provisions of this act shall not apply to the 2 municipalities of Bluefield, Huntington, Parkersburg and 3 Kenova, and the civil service commission created for the city 4 of Bluefield under an act of the Legislature, regular session, 5 one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, is hereby abolished.
