ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 183)

[Passed February 22, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Union district, Clay county, to make a transfer of money from the special fund for the transfer of pupils to Clay county high school to the elementary teachers' fund of said district.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of Union district, Clay county, is authorized to transfer four hundred dollars from the surplus in the special fund for the transfer of pupils to Clay county high school to the elementary teachers' fund of said district, to be expended as the law provides, for the payment of teachers' salaries for the fiscal year ending June thirty, one thousand nine hundred thirty three.
