ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 429)

[Passed March 1, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the boards of education of Clay, Union and Webster districts, Marshall county, to transfer certain funds in their respective districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the boards of education of Clay, Union 2 and Webster districts, Marshall county, are authorized to transfer such funds as they deem necessary in their respective school 4 funds to the elementary teachers' fund in said districts.
