AN ACT to amend and reenact an act of the legislature, session one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, effective from passage, and approved by the governor on the twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, entitled "An Act to amend article four, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to banking institutions, by the addition of a new section thereto designated and numbered six-(a); providing for the vesting in the board of directors of any banking institution additional authority in the management, operation and conduct of its business under the direction of the state banking commissioner and by and with the consent of the governor."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That an act of the legislature, session one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, effective from passage, and approved by the governor

on the twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, entitled "An Act to amend article four, chapter thirty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to banking institutions, by the addition of a new section thereto designated and numbered six-(a); providing for the vesting in the board of directors of any banking institution additional authority in the management, operation and conduct of its business under the direction of the state banking commissioner and by and with the consent of the governor," is hereby amended and reenacted so as to read:

Section 6-(a). The commissioner of banking may, by and with
2 the consent of the governor, permit or require any bank or bank-
3 ing institution authorized to do business in this state, or any
4 number or all of such banks or banking institutions, to:
5 (1) Operate and do business in such manner and under such
6 limitations and regulations as the banking commissioner,
7 with the approval of the governor, may prescribe, or,
8 (2) Cease business for such period of time as the banking
9 commissioner, with the approval of the governor, may direct, in
10 which case the period of such cessation shall be held to be a legal
11 holiday, as now defined, as to such bank or banks.
