~~AN ACT~~ to authorize the board of education of McElroy district, Tyler county, to transfer money from the new building fund to the teachers' fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of McElroy district, Tyler county, is hereby authorized to transfer money from the building funds of the district to the elementary teachers' fund for the purpose of enabling the board to maintain the elementary schools of the district for a full term of eight months for the fiscal year ending June thirty, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.
