## ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 555)

[Passed March 6, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend section six, article two, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the bonds of state officers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section six, article two, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 6. The following officers shall give bonds to be approved by the governor, in the penalties hereinafter named:

Secretary of state, twenty-five thousand dollars; auditor, fifty thousand dollars; treasurer, five hundred thousand dollars; state superintendent of free schools, three thousand dollars; and commissioner of agriculture, five thousand dollars.
