AN ACT to authorize and empower the board of education of Mill Run district, Pendleton county, to transfer nine hundred twelve dollars from the new building fund to the high school tuition fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the board of education of Mill Run district, Pendleton county, is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer nine hundred twelve dollars from the new building fund of said district to the high school tuition fund.
