(S. B. No. 112)

[Passed March 10, 1933; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section forty-six of the greater
Wheeling charter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section forty-six of the greater Wheeling charter be
amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 46. The council may, by ordinance, require city
2 license for persons conducting and carrying on any business or
3 vocation in the city, for which the state may now or hereafter
4 require license, except that the council may by ordinance, re-
5 quire license for persons, firms, or corporations conducting and
6 carrying on the business of contractors and subcontractors en-
7 gaged in building construction, of installing plumbing and
