ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 126)

[Passed February 28, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Washington district, Boone county, to transfer funds from the high school teachers' fund to the elementary teachers' fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of Washington district, Boone county, is authorized to transfer all or any part of fifteen hundred dollars from the high school teachers' fund to the elementary teachers' fund for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.
