ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 130)

[Passed March 11, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section twelve, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to bond of persons contracting for building or repairing of schoolhouses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twelve, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 12. Boards of education shall in all cases require 2 persons entering into contract for the building or repairing of 3 schoolhouses to execute bond as provided in section thirty-nine, 4 article two, chapter thirty-eight of this code.
