AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, article one, chapter thirty-nine of the code of West Virginia one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to certificate of acknowledgment of a corporation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nine, article one, chapter thirty-nine of the code of West Virginia one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 9. The certificate of acknowledgment of a corporation may be in form or effect as prescribed in section four of this article as far as the words "do certify" and thence as follows: do certify that....., who signed the
