## **ENROLLED BILL**

(S. B. No. 133)

[Passed March 11, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article seven, chapter fifty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to unlawful distraining.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article seven, chapter fifty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 3. If property be distrained for any rent not due,
2 or attached for any rent not accruing, or taken under any at3 tachment sued out without good cause, the owner of such prop4 erty may, in an action against the party suing out the warrant
