AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article two, chapter fifty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to venue for a quo warranto proceeding.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article two, chapter fifty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 2. Whenever the attorney general or prosecuting 2 attorney of any county is satisfied that a cause exists therefor 3 he may, at his own instance, or at the relation of any person 4 interested, apply by petition to the circuit court, or the judge

6 ment is, or of the county wherein the cause, or any part thereof,
7 for the issuing of such writ arose, to have such writ issued, and
8 shall state therein the reason therefor. Whenever such writ is
9 issued at the relation of any person, the petition shall be to the
10 circuit court, or the judge thereof in vacation, of the county
11 wherein the seat of government is, or of the county wherein
12 the cause, or any part thereof, for the issuing of such writ
13 arose, as the relator may elect. Any such writ may be awarded
14 either by the circuit court or by the judge thereof in vaca15 tion.
