ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 134)

[Passed March 11, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article two, chapter fifty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to venue for a quo warranto proceeding.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article two, chapter fifty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted so as to read as follows:

Section 2. Whenever the attorney general or prosecuting attorney of any county is satisfied that a cause exists therefor he may, at his own instance, or at the relation of any person interested, apply by petition to the circuit court, or the judge
