(By MR. BROTHERTON)

[Passed March 6, 1935; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT providing that wages and salaries of all officials, clerks
and employees of any city, town or county shall be subject to
garnishment or execution upon any judgment rendered against
them, unless otherwise exempt.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The purpose of this act is to permit any creditor
2 to garnish or attach the wages or salary of any debtor residing
3 within this state, whether or not such debtor is in the employ of
4 any municipality, county, or any other political subdivision of
5 this state; and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Legis-
6 lature to declare this act to be in the interest of public policy.

Sec. 2. All officers, clerks, school teachers and employees, of
2 any city, town or county who hold their office by virtue of au-
3 thority from the Legislature, or by virtue of authority from the

4 governor of the state of West Virginia, or by virtue of authority
5 from any city, town, board of education or county, whether by
6 election or by appointment, and who receive compensation for
7 their services from the moneys of such city, town or county
8 shall, for the purposes of attachment, suggestion, garnishment
9 and execution, be deemed to be, and are officers, clerks or em-
10 ployees of such city, town or county, and their wages or salaries
11 shall be subject to attachment, suggestion, garnishment or exe-
12 cution upon any judgment rendered against them, unless other-
13 wise exempt.
