AN ACT to authorize the county court of Fayette County to expend funds for the construction and maintenance of the Four-H camp in Fayette County.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The county court of Fayette county may expend  
2 annually from any funds available a sum not to exceed three  
3 thousand dollars for the construction and maintenance of the  
4 Fayette county Four-H camp heretofore established.
