AN ACT to authorize the board of county commissioners of Ohio  
County and the county court of Brooke County to provide additional compensation for special judges of courts of record within said county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The board of county commissioners of Ohio  
County and the county court of Brooke County are hereby authorized to provide additional compensation for special judges of all courts of record in said counties: *Provided*, That the amount of such additional compensation provided for any such judge, when added to the compensation payable to him out of the state treasury, shall not exceed the amount of the salary of the regular judge in whose place and stead such special judge serves.


