AN ACT to amend and reenact sections ninety-one and ninety-two, chapter one, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, relating to the appropriations from the state road commission fund to the state road commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections ninety-one and ninety-two, chapter one, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
