(BY MR. HAYTHE, by request)

[Passed March 9, 1935; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to transfer the county of Summers from the tenth judicial circuit to the eleventh judicial circuit and fixing the times of holding the circuit courts in the eleventh judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the county of Summers which is now a part of the tenth judicial circuit, composed of the counties of Boone, Raleigh and Summers, be and the same is hereby transferred to and shall, on and after the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven, become a part of the eleventh judicial circuit, then to be composed of the counties of Greenbrier, Monroe, Pocahontas and Summers.

Sec. 2. The times for holding court within said eleventh judicial circuit to be so constituted shall be as follows:

3 For the county of Pocahontas: Second Tuesday in March,
4 first Tuesday in June, and the first Tuesday in October of
5 each year.

6 For the county of Greenbrier: Third Tuesday in January,
7 first Tuesday in May, first Tuesday in August and the fourth
8 Tuesday in November of each year.

9 For the county of Monroe: First Tuesday in April, second
10 Tuesday in July, and the second Tuesday in November of
11 each year.


12 For the county of Summers: First Tuesday in January,
13 third Tuesday in April, third Tuesday in July, and third
14 Tuesday in October of each year.

Sec. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act
2 are hereby repealed.

I certify that the foregoing bill,
having been presented to the Governor for
his approval, and not having been returned
by him to the House of the Legislature in
which it originated within the time pre-
scribed by the constitution of the state, has
become a law without his approval.
