[Passed March 9, 1935; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to appropriate moneys from the treasury to further supplement the general school fund for the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-four—one thousand nine hundred thirty-five.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. It appearing from a statement of the revenues and appropriations for the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-four—one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, that there remains in the treasury, state fund general revenue, revenue in excess of the amount hereby appropriated, there is hereby appropriated from the state fund general revenue for the remainder of the current fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-four—one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, to

9 supplement the general school fund to pay on the account of
10 teacher's salaries for the ninth month of the current school
11 year, the sum of seven hundred thousand dollars to be trans-
12 ferred from the state fund general revenue to the general school
13 fund upon the requisition of the Governor at such times and
14 in such amounts as in his opinion the condition of the treasury
15 warrants.
