(By Mr. Greene)

[Passed February 4, 1935; in effect March, 1 1935]

AN ACT to transfer the county of Mingo from the eighth judicial circuit to the twenty-fourth judicial circuit, and fixing the time of holding the terms of circuit court therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county of Mingo, which is now a part of 2 the eighth judicial circuit, composed of the counties of Mc-3 Dowell and Mingo, be, and the same is, hereby transferred to 4 and shall, on and after the first day of March, one thousand 5 nine hundred thirty-five, or as soon thereafter as this act 6 shall take effect, become a part of the twenty-fourth judicial 7 circuit, which shall be composed of the counties of Mingo

- 8 and Wayne; the judge of the twenty-fourth judicial circuit
 9 now serving, shall continue as judge thereof, including the
 10 county of Mingo, for his unexpired term, with the authority,
 11 powers, duties, compensation and emoluments of said office as
- 12 provided by the constitution and laws relating to circuit judges.

Sec. 2. The terms of circuit court, in the counties com-

- 2 posing the twenty-fourth judicial circuit, as aforesaid, shall
- 3 commence and be held each year as follows:
- 4 For the county of Mingo, on the first Monday in January,
- 5 May and October; for the county of Wayne, on the second
- 6 Monday in March and July, and the fourth Monday in
- 7 November.
- 8 All acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby 9 repealed.

having been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislat re in which it originated within the time proscribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
