(BY MR. BEACOM)

[Passed February 26, 1935; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Cabell county to transfer certain funds now available in the general emergency fund to pay salaries due certain teachers in Guyandotte district for the school year one thousand nine hundred thirty-two—one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. That the board of education of Cabell county is  
2 authorized to transfer any school fund or funds available in  
3 the general emergency fund to compensate certain teachers  
4 of Guyandotte district for services rendered during the fiscal  
5 year ending June thirty, one thousand nine hundred thirty-  
6 three.
