AN ACT making disposition of the exhibit of the State of West
Virginia, used at the Century of Progress Exhibition at
Chicago.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The exhibit heretofore had at the century of
2 progress exhibition, assembled and erected at Chicago by the
3 commissioner of agriculture pursuant to the provisions of
4 senate concurrent resolution six, regular session, one thousand
5 nine hundred thirty-three, which has been returned to the state
6 of West Virginia as provided by said resolution and is now
7 located at the state four-H camp at Jackson's Mill, is hereby

8 committed to the custody of the board of governors of West
9 Virginia University, to be kept and preserved by said board
10 at said state four-H camp at Jackson's Mill, as other property
11 of the state located at said camp and subject to the same laws
12 and regulations applicable thereto.
