ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 30

(By Mr. Spillers)

[Passed February 23, 1935; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article five, chapter thirty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new section to be known as section six, providing for the creation and validation of perpetual trusts for the care, preservation, maintenance, improvement or embellishment of cemetery or burial lots, public or private, and structures and growths thereon.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article five, chapter thirty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be known as section six, as follows:

Section 6. Express trusts may hereafter be created for the 2 perpetual care, preservation, maintenance, improvement and/or 3 embellishment of any cemetery or burial lot, public or private, 4 and of the appurtenances of any such lot, including the erec-5 tion, repair, preservation and/or removal of mausoleums, tombs, 6 monuments, gravestones, fences, railings, walks, and/or other 7 structure or structures thereon, and the planting, trimming, 8 watering and/or removing of any tree, shrub or other plant 9 or plants thereon. Any such trust heretofore created shall be 10 valid. Any such trust whether created heretofore or hereafter, 11 may provide for the accumulation of income for any of the 12 aforesaid purposes, but if and when the accumulations so 13 authorized exceed the replacement cost of all structures upon 14 such lot, the trustee of such trust may, either with or without 15 authorization of any court having jurisdiction in the premises, 16 divert the excess thereover to the general upkeep of the ceme-17 tery. Any person or any association of persons or corporation 18 authorized by the laws of this state to act as trustee, may serve 19 as trustee of any such trust. The funds in any such trust shall 20 be invested in the manner provided in the instrument creating

- 21 same, but, in the absence of any such provisions, in the manner
- 22 provided by article six, chapter forty-four, of the code of West
- 23 Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one.

having been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislature in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
