[Passed June 20, 1936; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to appropriate moneys from the treasury for the purpose
of carrying into effect the Public Welfare Law of one thousand
nine hundred thirty-six.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. It appearing from a statement of the revenues
2 and appropriations for the fiscal years one thousand nine
3 hundred thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six
4 and one thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thousand
5 nine hundred thirty-seven, that there will remain in the
6 treasury, state fund general revenue, revenue in excess of the
7 amount hereby appropriated, there is hereby appropriated
8 from the state fund general revenue for the fiscal year one

9 thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thousand nine hundred
10 thirty-seven, the sum of two million five hundred thousand
11 dollars to the Department of Public Assistance for the pur-
12 pose of being expended in carrying into effect the Public
13 Welfare Law of one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, to be
14 expended upon requisitions drawn upon the Auditor by the
15 proper officials of the Department of Public Assistance.
