(By MR. LAFON)

[Passed June 19, 1936; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to appropriate moneys from the treasury to the auditor's  
office for carrying into effect the delinquent tax redemption  
laws.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. It appearing from a statement of the revenues  
2 and appropriations for the fiscal years one thousand nine  
3 hundred thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six  
4 and one thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thousand  
5 nine hundred thirty-seven, that there remains in the treasury  
6 state fund general revenue, revenue in excess of the amounts  
7 hereby appropriated, there is hereby appropriated from the  
8 state fund general revenue to the auditor's office for the  
9 fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-five—one thou-

10 sand nine hundred thirty-six, the sum of thirteen thousand  
11 seven hundred seven dollars and twenty-five cents, and for the  
12 fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thou-  
13 sand nine hundred thirty-seven, the sum of thirty-one thou-  
14 sand three hundred sixty dollars, to be expended to meet the  
15 deficiency in the appropriation for the current fiscal year  
16 one thousand nine hundred thirty-five—one thousand nine  
17 hundred thirty-six, occasioned by the unexpectedly large num-  
18 ber of requests for redemption and to be expended in carry-  
19 ing out the provisions of an act of the Legislature, first  
20 extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-six,  
21 known and designated as house bill number two.
