(By MR. THOMAS)

[Passed June 10, 1936; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to appropriate moneys from the treasury to the Department of Labor for cooperation with the federal government in maintaining the West Virginia State Employment Service.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. It appearing from a statement of the revenues
2 and appropriations for the fiscal years one thousand nine
3 hundred thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six,
4 and one thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thousand
5 nine hundred thirty-seven, that there remains in the treasury,
6 state fund general revenue, revenue in excess of the amount
7 hereby appropriated, there is hereby appropriated from the
8 state fund general revenue to the department of labor for the
9 fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-six—one thou-

10 sand nine hundred thirty-seven, the sum of three thousand
11 five hundred dollars, to be expended upon the requisition of
12 the Commissioner of Labor for the maintenance of West Vir-
13 ginia Employment Service in cooperation with the Depart-
14 ment of Labor of the United States.
