AN ACT to appropriate moneys from the treasury to continue unemployment relief for the remainder of the current fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. It appearing from a statement of revenues and  
2 appropriations for the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred  
3 thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, that there  
4 remains in the treasury, state fund general revenue, revenue  
5 in excess of the amount hereby appropriated, there is hereby  
6 appropriated from the state fund general revenue for the  
7 remainder of the current fiscal year one thousand nine hun-  
8 dred thirty-five—one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, the

9 sum of one hundred five thousand dollars for the purpose of  
10 affording relief to needy persons for the remainder of the  
11 current fiscal year, to be expended upon the requisition of the  
12 Governor.
