AN ACT to appropriate money out of the treasury for the purpose
of carrying into effect the Unemployment Compensation Law
of one thousand nine hundred thirty-six.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Appropriation to Department of Unemployment*
2 *Compensation.* It appearing from the statement of the reve-
3 nues of the current fiscal year and of the appropriations
4 therefor that there remains in the general revenue for the
5 current fiscal year, unappropriated, an amount in excess of
6 the amount appropriated by this act, there is hereby appro-
7 priated to the Department of Unemployment Compensation
8 for the remainder of the current fiscal year ending June

9 thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven, the sum
10 of twenty thousand dollars, to be expended upon requisitions
11 drawn upon the Auditor by the proper officials of the De-
12 partment of Unemployment Compensation.
