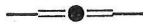

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seventy-five, article two, chapter twenty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the weighing of coal.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section seventy-five, article two, chapter twenty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**Section 75. *Weighing Coal Before Screening; Payment for***

2 *Coal.* All coal so mined and paid for by weight shall be  
3 weighed before it is screened, and shall be paid for according  
4 to the weight so ascertained, at such price per ton as may be  
5 agreed on by such owner or operators and the miners who

6 mined the same. And coal mined and paid for by measure  
7 shall be paid for according to the number of bushels marked  
8 upon each car in which it is removed from the mine, and  
9 before it is screened, and the price paid for each bushel so  
10 ascertained shall be such as may be agreed upon as afore-  
11 said.
