[Passed February 12, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-n, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to the time of terms of the circuit court for the counties of Braxton, Clay, Gilmer and Webster.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-n, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-n. *Terms of Court in Fourteenth Circuit.* For

2 the county of Braxton, on the second Monday in March, July

3 and November.

4 For the county of Clay, on the first Monday in February,

5 June and October.

6 For the county of Gilmer, on the third Monday in Feb-
7 ruary, June and October.

8 For the county of Webster, on the second Monday in Janu-
9 ary, May and September.
