**House Bill No. 131**

(By MR. STEPHENS)

[Passed March 6, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the county court of Kanawha county to provide compensation for George Dudley, a former deputy sheriff of Kanawha county, wounded while in the performance of his duty as deputy sheriff.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Authorizing Kanawha County Court to Pay Compensation to George Dudley.* That the county court of Kanawha county be authorized and empowered to pay to George Dudley, a former deputy sheriff of Kanawha county, the sum of two hundred fifty dollars in cash, and to make provision in its annual budget, each year, during the remainder of the life of the said Dudley, beginning with the budget for the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred thirty-seven

9 and thirty-eight, and to appropriate for each fiscal year  
10 thereafter, during the life of the said Dudley, the sum of  
11 nine hundred sixty dollars annually, to be paid monthly by  
12 the county court of Kanawha county, to the said George W.  
13 Dudley, in monthly installments of eighty dollars per month,  
14 as compensation to the said George Dudley for injuries sus-  
15 tained, while transporting a dangerous criminal from the  
16 Kanawha county jail to the West Virginia state penitentiary  
17 at Moundsville, when attacked and severely wounded by  
18 outlaws.

I certify that the foregoing act,  
having been presented to the Governor for  
his approval, and not having been returned  
by him to the House of the Legislature in  
which it originated within the time pre-  
scribed by the constitution of the state, has  
become a law without his approval.
