AN ACT to amend and reenact sections four and twenty, article one, chapter forty-seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to weights and measures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections four and twenty, article one, chapter forty-seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. *Commissioner of Weights and Measures; Deputies;*

2 *Inspectors.* The state commissioner of labor shall be ex
3 officio commissioner of weights and measures, and he shall be
4 authorized to appoint such deputies and inspectors as may
5 be required to carry out the provisions and purposes of this

6 article within the limits of such appropriation as may be
7 made by the Legislature for the maintenance of the work of
8 the department of labor.

Sec. 20. Records and Reports of County and City Sealers.

2 The county or city sealer shall keep a complete record of all
3 his official acts, and shall submit monthly reports, and shall
4 make an annual report duly sworn to on the first day of July,
5 to the state commissioner of weights and measures, on blanks
6 furnished by the commissioner.
