AN ACT to amend article two, chapter two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section twelve, relating to headings of acts of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section twelve as follows:

Section 12. *Headings Et Cetera, Not Part of Acts.* The
2 chapter, article or section headings, headlines or headnotes
3 of any act of the Legislature, whether in the act at the time
4 of passage or inserted after passage by the Clerk of the House
5 of Delegates in editing and compiling the acts of the Legis-

6 lature, shall be construed as mere catchwords and shall not
7 be deemed or taken to be titles of such chapters, articles or
8 sections, or as any part of the act.
