AN ACT to permit the county court of Webster County, with the consent of the holders of certificates of indebtedness, to post-pone the payment of such certificates; and to employ and use the levy therefor, along with any surplus in said fund, existing or arising in the construction of additions, repairs and reconditioning of the county courthouse of Webster County.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Webster County Court Authorized to Postpone

- 7 and balances now in the contractual debt fund derived from
- 8 other sources, in providing for additions, reconstruction and
- 9 repairs to the courthouse of the said county; and such mon-
- 10 eys may be so expended in conjunction with any moneys
- 11 allocated in aid of such purposes by the government of the
- 12 United States, or any agency established by it, or independ-

13 ently thereof.

Sec. 3. County Court to Provide by Levies for Payment of

- 2 Certificates of Indebtedness; Inconsistent Acts Repealed. The
- 3 said county court of Webster County shall make provision
- 4 for the payment of the certificates of indebtedness, the pay-
- 5 ment of which may be postponed under the provisions of this
- 6 act, by levies for the fiscal year ending June thirty, one thou-
- 7 sand nine hundred forty.
- 8 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent or in conflict herewith
- 9 are hereby repealed.
