## ENROLLED House Bill No. 341

(By Mr. ISAACS)

[Passed March 12, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Lincoln County to set aside and expend a part of the levies which it is now authorized by law to lay for school purposes, to be used for the construction of foot-bridges across and over the rivers, creeks and other streams of the county, in aid of the transportation of, or in otherwise facilitating pupils in going to and from school.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the board of education of the county of Lincoln, may, in aid of its transportation of pupils to and from public schools, and in otherwise facilitating the attendance of pupils at any school, at which they are entitled to attend, do and perform acts and deed: as follows: Enrolled H. B. No. 341]

Section 1. Lincoln County Board of Education Authorized to Lay Levy. Whenever the board of education of the 2 3 county of Lincoln shall determine that it is for the best in-4 terests of the pupils attending any school, and for the board 5 of education in transporting pupils to and from any such school, said board shall have the right, if exercised at the 6 7 time of making estimates and the laying of levies for school 8 purposes as provided by law, to set aside and appropriate 9 from the amount which may be raised from the whole of the levies which the board may be now or hereafter authorized 10 11 to lay for school purposes, an amount equal to such sum as 12 might be raised by a levy of seven cents on each one hun-11 13 dred dollars' valuation of the taxable property of said coun-204 4 113.5 14 ty, for the purpose of constructing foot-bridges across any 19 15 river, creek or other stream.

Sec. 2. Board May Expend Funds for Foot Bridges. When
2 funds are set aside as provided in section one of this act,
3 the board of education may expend same for the construction
4 of foot-bridges over and across rivers, creeks and other
5 streams, for the accommodation of pupils attending schools.
Sec. 3. Board May Acquire Lands for Bridges. The board

2 of education shall have the right to acquire, by gift, pur3 chase or other voluntary method, or by condemnation in the
4 manner prescribed by law, lands, easements, and all other
5 properties necessary for the construction of bridges and ap6 proaches thereto, as herein provided.

7 All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions8 of this act are hereby repealed.

I certify that the foregoing act, taving been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislature in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
