House Bill No. 358

[Passed March 10, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and provide for the acceptance by the state
of federal aid which may be made available during a period
when the Legislature is not in session.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Governor Empowered to Take Action Necessary
to Secure Federal Funds When Legislature Not in Session.*

The Governor is hereby authorized and empowered to take
whatever action not contrary to law that he may find proper
and necessary to enable the state to receive the benefits of
appropriations which may be made by the congress of the
United States while the Legislature is not in session.

Sec. 2. *Designation of State Department or Agency to
Secure Federal Funds.* A department, institution or agency

3 of the state government designated by congress, in the event
4 contemplated in section one and with the approval of the
5 Governor, shall have authority to do all acts not contrary to
6 law which may be necessary for enforcement with the re-
7 quirements and conditions for the receipt of such federal
8 appropriations.

Sec. 3. *Governor Has Authority to Order Transfers.* The
2 Governor shall have authority to order transfers within the
3 items of appropriations for such department, institution or
4 agency as may be necessary to effectuate the purpose of this
5 act (and not contrary to law).
