

ENROLLED House Bill No. 414

(By MR. DORINGER)

[Passed March 13, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article six, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding to said article a new section to be designated section fourteen-a, providing for the collection of an arrest fee for the benefit of policemen's pension or relief fund, to be taxed as part of costs in convictions for violation of municipal ordinances when arrest is made by a member of the police department.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article six, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section fourteen-a, to read as follows:

Section 14-a. When Arrest Fee to be Collected for Munici-

2 pal Policemen's Pension or Relief Fund. In cases of the 3 conviction for violation of any municipal ordinance of any person arrested by any member of the police department of 4 any city or municipality having a policemen's pension or 5 relief fund an arrest fee of one dollar shall be taxed as part 6 7 of the costs, in addition to other fees authorized by law, and shall be collected from the person convicted, and such arrest 8 fee shall be paid into the policemen's pension or relief fund. 9

I certify that the foregoing act, laving been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislative in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
