AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Randolph  
County to transfer unexpended balances in the general county  
road fund to the general county fund of said county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Randolph County Court Authorized to Trans-*  
2 *fer Funds.* The county court of Randolph County is hereby  
3 authorized and empowered to transfer the unexpended bal-  
4 ances in the general county road fund of said county remain-  
5 ing and not needed for the payment and satisfaction of all  
6 claims and expenses against said fund, to the general county  
7 fund of said county.

- 8 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby  
9 repealed, insofar as they may apply to Randolph County.

I certify that the foregoing act, having been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislature in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
