AN ACT to authorize the county court of Clay County to pay to  
J. B. Wheeler, ex-sheriff of Clay County, extra expense au-  
thorized by a former county court of Clay County.


*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Clay County Court Authorized to Pay Certain*  
2 *Expenses of J. B. Wheeler, Former Sheriff.* The county  
3 court of Clay County, West Virginia, is hereby authorized  
4 to pay to J. B. Wheeler of Clay, West Virginia, former  
5 sheriff of said Clay County for the term expiring January  
6 first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, the sum of  
7 three hundred dollars, to cover his extra expense while in  
8 office, authorized by the county court of Clay County then  
9 in office, but never paid to him.


