AN ACT relating to expenditure of money for memorial for Confederate Veterans of Shepherdstown and vicinity.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. The board of control is hereby authorized and  
2 shall expend from the state fund general revenue the sum of  
3 seven hundred fifty dollars for the purpose of aiding the  
4 Henry Kyd Douglas Camp of Sons of the Confederate  
5 Veterans to erect a memorial to the Confederate Veterans of  
6 Shepherdstown and vicinity. Said sum, or any part thereof,  
7 shall be expended with the advice and counsel of the said  
8 Henry Kyd Douglas Camp Sons of Confederate Veterans.
