AN ACT to amend article two-a, chapter forty, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, by adding a new section to be numbered eighteen, relating to the sale of property of the state road commission.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article two-a, chapter forty, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, be amended by adding section eighteen, to read as follows:

Section 18. The state road commissioner shall have the  
2 authority, by and with the consent of the governor, to sell  
3 or exchange any property, real or personal, held by it, and  
4 any sale or exchange of such property heretofore made by  
5 the commissioner is hereby ratified and declared valid.

I certify that the foregoing act,  
having been presented to the Governor for  
his approval, and not having been returned  
by him to the House of the Legislature in  
which it originated within the time pre-  
scribed by the constitution of the state, has  
become a law without his approval.
