AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, chapter twentyfive, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, one thousand
nine hundred seven, relating to the time for holding terms
of the Intermediate Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature cf West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. There shall be four terms of said court held
2 in each year, commencing on the second Monday in January,
