AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred seven, relating to the time for holding terms of the Intermediate Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. There shall be four terms of said court held
2 in each year, commencing on the second Monday in January,

3 the first Monday in April, the second Monday in June and
4 the first Monday in September. Adjourned and special terms
5 of said court may be called and held as provided for special
6 and adjourned terms of the circuit court.
