## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 323

(By Mr. Belknap) (by request)

[Passed March 13, 1937; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article three, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to payment of money out of the state treasury.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article three, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. Every person claiming to receive money from 2 the treasury of the state shall apply to the auditor for a

warrant for the same. The auditor shall thereupon examine the claim, and the vouchers, certificates and evidence, if any, offered in support thereof, and for so much thereof as he 5 shall find to be justly due from the state, if payment thereof be authorized by law, and if there be an appropriation not 7 exhausted or expired out of which it is properly payable, he shall issue his warrant on the treasurer, specifying to 10 whom and on what account the money mentioned therein 11 is to be paid, and to what appropriation the same is to be 12 charged. On the presentation of such warrant to the 13 treasurer, he shall ascertain whether the same has been 14 drawn in pursuance of an appropriation made by law, and 15 if he finds it to be so, he shall in that case, but not otherwise, indorse his check upon such warrant, directed to some 16 depository, which check shall be payable to the order of 17 18 the person who is to receive the money therein specified. 19 If such check shall not be presented for payment within 20 three years after it is drawn, it shall then be the duty of the treasurer to charge it again to the depository on which 21 22 it was drawn, to credit the state fund with the amount, 23 and immediately to notify the auditor to make correspond-

ing entries on his books. No state depository shall pay a 25 check unless it is presented within six months after it is drawn, and the treasurer is hereby authorized to cover into 26 27 the treasury, by appropriate entries, all checks that have been outstanding for three years or over. Every check 28 29 shall bear upon is face the words, "Void, unless presented 30 for payment within six months." All claims required by 31 law to be allowed by any court, and payable out of the state 32 treasury, shall have the seal of the court allowing or au-33 thorizing the payment of the same affixed by the clerk of 34 such court to his certificate of its allowance; and no such claim shall be audited and paid by the auditor unless the 35 36 seal of such court be thereto attached as aforesaid. No tax or fee shall be charged by the clerk for affixing his seal to 37 38 the certificate referred to in this section.
