AN ACT to amend article nineteen, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirteen-a, relating to the driver or operator of a motor vehicle transporting explosives and providing penalties for violations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article nineteen, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated section thirteen-a, to read as follows:

Section 13-a. Transportation of Explosives; Penalties.

- 2 No driver or operator of a motor vehicle upon the "public
- 3 roads" as defined in section thirteen, article nineteen, chapter

- 4 seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine
- 5 hundred thirty-one, transporting gasoline, gunpowder, dyna-
- 6 mite, nitro-glycerine and/or other explosives, shall approach
- 7 any railroad crossing without first coming to a full stop at
- 8 a distance of not less than ten feet from said crossing, and
- 9 after restarting said motor vehicle he shall proceed at a re-
- 10 stricted rate of speed until he shall have crossed said rail-
- 11 road tracks.
- 12 Anyone violating any of the provisions of this section shall
- 13 be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall
- 14 be fined not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty
- 15 dollars, and shall be subject to revocation of his operator's
- 16 license as provided in section twenty-eight, article six of this
