[Passed March 12, 1937; in effect April 1, 1937]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article one, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as the same was last amended and reenacted by chapter forty-three, acts of the Legislature, second extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, relating to duties of county courts for services other than services in court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, article one, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as the same was last amended and reenacted by chapter forty-three, acts of the Legislature, second extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. *Duties and Salaries of County Commissioners.*

2 It shall be the duty of the county commissioners of each
3 county to visit each quarter and inspect institutions within
4 their county for housing and caring for the poor, to inspect
5 the jails, and to investigate the conditions of the poor within
6 their county not housed within such institutions; to visit de-
7 tention homes for children within their counties, if any, and
8 to visit and inspect bridges and bridge approaches under their
9 control, and for reviewing and equalizing the assessments
10 made by the assessor, and for duties of the county commis-
11 sioners in cooperating with the county public assistance coun-
12 cil, and for supervising and general management of the fiscal
13 affairs and business of each county.


14 There shall be allowed and paid out of the county treasury,
15 as other salaries are paid, to each county commissioner of
16 each county, (except as otherwise provided by law for the
17 county of Ohio), for services performed for such county con-
18 cerning the visiting of the poor, and inspection of places of
19 housing and caring for the poor, inspection of jails, bridges
20 and bridge approaches and for visiting detention homes for
21 children, and for reviewing and equalizing the assessments

22 made by the assessor, and for duties of the county commis-
23 sioners in cooperating with the county public assistance coun-
24 cil, and for supervising and general management of the fiscal
25 affairs and business of each county, within their counties and
26 other county business by such commissioners in addition to
27 compensation for services in court, the following sums of
28 money, to-wit: The county of Barbour fifteen dollars per
29 month, the county of Berkeley thirty dollars per month, the
30 county of Boone thirty-five dollars per month, the county of
31 Braxton forty dollars per month, the county of Brooke thirty-
32 five dollars per month, the county of Cabell two hundred
33 dollars per month, the county of Calhoun twenty-five dollars
34 per month, the county of Clay thirty-five dollars per month,
35 the county of Doddridge fifteen dollars per month, the county
36 of Fayette one hundred fifty dollars per month, the county
37 of Gilmer twenty-five dollars per month, the county of Grant
38 twenty dollars per month, the county of Greenbrier fifty dol-
39 lars per month, the county of Hampshire twenty-five dollars
40 per month, the county of Hancock thirty-five dollars per
