AN ACT to amend article three, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, by adding a new section thereto to be designated as section four, relating to the leasing of lands owned by county courts for gas, oil and other minerals.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article three, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, be amended by adding a new section thereto, to be designated section four, to read as follows:

Section 4. Leasing of County Lands for Minerals. The

- 2 county court of any county may lease for oil or gas or other
- 3 minerals, any lands owned in fee by it, the rentals, royalties

- 4 or proceeds of any such lease to be placed to the credit of the
- 5 general county fund of the county.

I certify that the foregoing act, maying been presented to the Governor for his approval, and not having been returned by him to the House of the Legislature in which it originated within the time prescribed by the constitution of the state, has become a law without his approval.
